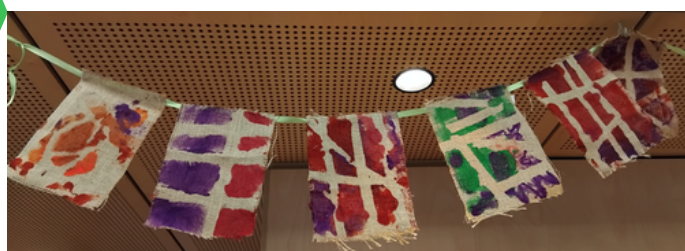
Term 3 highlights...

We began Term 3 with NAIDOC week and the Peppermint students made this wonderful Bungil eagle together, by each creating one feather.

We explored some great artists from history including Picasso, Da Vinci and Grant Wood, and we gave their art works new hair dos.

Our art element for the term was 'texture,' with a focus on textiles and recycled materials. When exploring textiles, students used natural and synthetic fibres, such as hessian (from plants), wool (from animals) and acrylic yarn (man made plastic fibres).

The students used their sense to feel and explore the rough fibres of the plant based hessian and were invited to create a geometric design using masking tape on the textile, which was then painted over and torn off. The flags make our hallway look interesting and welcoming.
