Rocky River Public School Project update | December 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are providing an update on the Building A project at Rocky River Public School that we confirmed on 1 July 2024.

The department has awarded a contract to Kelso Services to relocate all the services such as water, gas and electricity away from Building A during the Summer School Holidays. Kelso Services will also work with Telstra to relocate the data feed to Building E.

Due to these services being located underground, earth moving equipment such as excavators will be on the school grounds during the holiday period.

This relocation work is to allow for the safe demolition of Building A in early 2025 and to limit disruption to school operations.

Demolition and rebuild

The department will open the tender period for a design consultant in December 2024. The tender is scheduled to be awarded to the consultant in February 2025 with design work beginning during Term 1 2025.

It is anticipated that demolition work will begin in the first half of 2025.

Managing work over summer

The services work will take place between 7am and 6pm and we will ensure they are carried out safely and efficiently to minimise impacts to the community.
