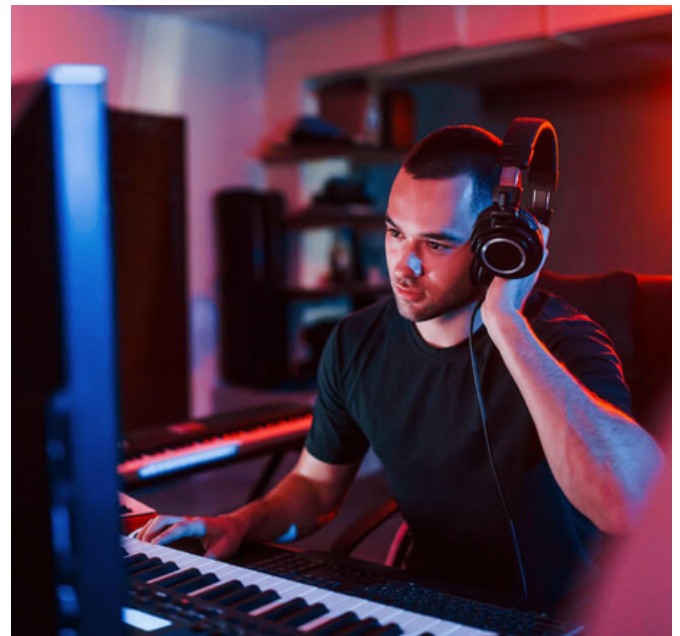

Applicants can choose from a wide variety of farm types including dairy, beef, grains, forestry, cotton, sheep horticulture, and other livestock industries such as poultry or pork. A matching process is undertaken to ensure participants are assigned to the type of farms that match their interests and skills.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Anyone aged from 17-25 can apply
- Need to be legally able to work in Australia
- Driver's licence preferred, but not essential
- Previous experience in agriculture not required

Elevate Women in STEM Scholarships

The Australian Academy of Technological Sciences & Engineering's [Elevate: Boosting Women in STEM program](#) is awarding undergraduate scholarships to women and non-binary people in STEM. The program provides:

- A scholarship
- Access to events and networking
- Mentoring
- Ongoing support during university studies

Eligibility criteria:

- Identify as a woman or non-binary person
- Be enrolling as a domestic student
- Be planning to undertake a STEM degree or higher studies to improve business acumen at an Australian university, commencing in 2024

Applications for the 2024 Elevate program close at 5:00pm (AEST) 31 August 2023.

Take a 5 Minute Brain Break



A 5-minute break helps restore your attention

Researchers from University of Sydney have found a 5-minute break from thinking is all you need to get your concentration back. “If you want your work or study to be more productive, you need to build in simple five-minute breaks of doing nothing,” said [Associate Professor Paul Ginns](#), an expert in educational psychology at University of Sydney. “You need to be doing something different for five minutes...to rest your brain from the task. Scrolling through social media does not count as rest – you need to take a break from devices.”
