Jasmine McGough, our beautiful and talented young friend, was seriously injured in an accident on a recent family holiday. We are leaning on our generous community for support and funding to enable her access to the necessary resources for ongoing, long-term care and extensive rehabilitation.

On July 5th 2022, Jas was holidaying in Margaret River when she fell from her mountain bike, fracturing her C5 vertebrate and in turn, was airlifted to Royal Perth Hospital. Despite immediate surgery to remove the pressure, her spinal cord was severely damaged resulting in a complete spinal cord injury.

Jasmine is a 14-year-old local Trigg girl, known for her beautiful smile, kind heart and natural athleticism, enjoying success in a variety of sports including Surf Club, netball, and swimming. More recently she had fallen in love with cycling after being picked up through the "WAIS Talent Identification Program" in September of 2021 and was chosen to represent WA at the Junior National Track Cycling Championships. She trained hard and brought home Gold, Silver and Bronze medals for our state. An incredible achievement. Her dream goal had her eyes set on the Olympic Games in Brisbane, 2032.

Jas is being cared for by a dedicated team of specialists and nurses in ICU at Royal Perth Hospital. It will be some 6-9 months before we know what future functionality she will have.
