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Mini Mission

The students have been working very hard at creating their stalls in preparation for Mini Mission. This will be held at St James on Monday 24th July from 11am-1pm. Confirmation

We are all looking forward to our Confirmation on 12th August. In preparation, we have a Retreat Day at St John's. The students will be required to complete a mini-project all about their chosen saint. This task will be completed at home and at school. By now you will have received all the information about making a banner. Please allow enough time to complete this for your child to bring to the Retreat Day on Friday 21st July (week 2).

In this unit students learn about the Holy Spirit in Scripture and through an introduction to the study of Confirmation. They learn of the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. They begin to explore Confirmation as a Sacrament and a celebration. At the conclusion of this unit, students explore ways in which they can use their gifts and talents to serve God and others.

Integrated Inquiry

This term our Integrated Inquiry unit focuses on Science. Our unit is titled, 'How do I adapt in an ever changing world?' Students will be exploring physical and chemical science and how science has changed many aspects of our everyday lives. The unit will finish with a Year 6 Science Fair.

English

The students will be developing their ability to take notes from oral sources and read and interpret a variety of text types. They will explore film and analyse the different techniques used. Throughout the term, students will be writing biographies, information reports and a variety of poetry. We will be having a large focus on vocabulary development.

Mathematics

The students will be continuing to focus on developing their skills in fractions, decimals and percentages. They will explore Chance experiments and explain their reasoning using their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages. In conjunction with participating in the Mini Mission Fete, students will explore money, focusing on calculating discounts on purchases. In the area of measurement, students will learn about shape and angles.

It is important that students continue to strengthen their number facts and multiplication tables. Remember -Mangahigh is always a fantastic resource to use at home.

Please remember to email BOTH classroom teachers and the office in the morning if students are going to be away, before 8:45am if possible.

Diaries will be checked each Wednesday.

There will be a homework club for students who have not completed this.
