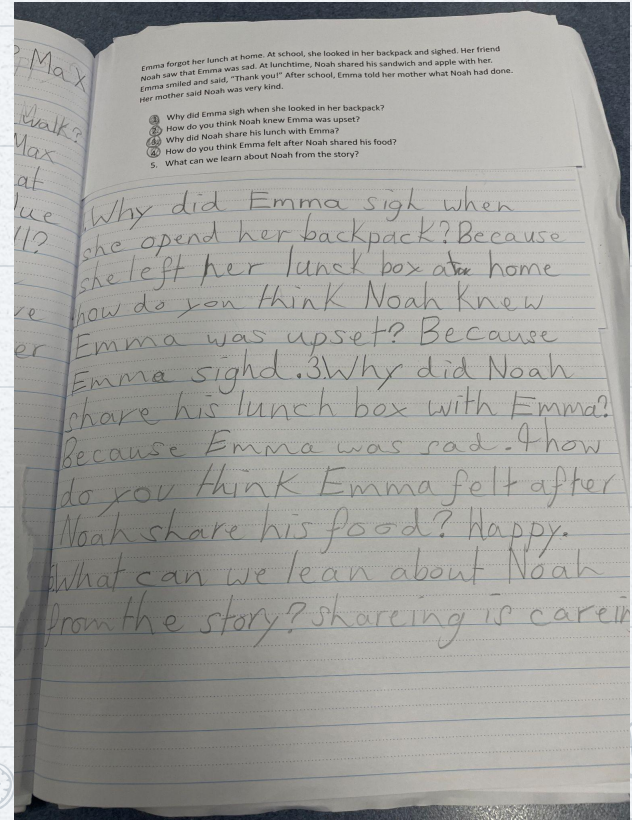
# INTRODUCTION
