Re: Works – Echuca-Mooroopna Road (Echuca Road), Mooroopna

Dear Stakeholder,

We're delivering works on approximately 1.2km of Echuca-Mooroopna Road (Echuca Road) in Mooroopna between Baker Crescent (south) and Paisley Crescent (south).

These works, delivered by Downer, will involve reconstructing the road to restore the condition of the road surface.

When to expect us

We're working between 7am and 6pm from early November 2024 to late March 2025, excluding public holidays and a two-week break over the Christmas/New Year period.

Some weekend and night works may be required to minimise traffic disruption and to keep our crews safe. Disruption will be minimised wherever possible.

Please note these dates and times are subject to change due to weather conditions.

What to expect

During works traffic management will be in place to allow the works to be delivered efficiently and keep our workers safe.

Traffic impacts and disruption;

- The closure of local roads intersecting with Echuca-Mooroopna Road will be required at times during the works. Signed detours will be place.
- The traffic signals at the intersection with Macisaac Road will be deactivated at times during works with a signed detour in place via the local road network. There will also be an alternative heavy vehicle detour via Ardmona Road.
- There will be no on-street parking on Echuca-Mooroopna Road and some sections of the adjacent service road during the works. Directly impacted property/business owners will be contacted to ensure access is maintained.

- Signalised pedestrian crossings and footpaths will be inaccessible at times during the works. Please observe changes on-site.
- Some noise, dust and vibration may be experienced in the vicinity of the works site. For the safety of our crews, reverse beepers are required on all equipment. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible.
- There will be lane closures and reduced speeds in place during the works with an expected delay of five to ten minutes. Please observe changed traffic conditions, plan ahead and allow extra time.
