Year 2, Term 3



Welcome to Term 3!

The year 2 students will be learning about...

Literacy: Recounts as a type of informative text.

Math: 2D and 3D shapes and their features and then go into fractions.

Inquiry: Fairness, respect, and multiculturalism by exploring their own and others' cultures through food, games, and traditions.

Tips for learning at home

Literacy: Ask your child to tell you about their day using time words like first, then, next, and finally.

Encourage them to write and draw about special events, weekends, or outings.

Help them add details by asking questions like "What happened next?" or "How did you feel?"

Read simple recounts together (e.g., diary entries or news for kids) and talk about what makes them interesting and informative.

Maths: Go on a shape hunt around the house or neighbourhood and talk about the features of each shape (e.g., sides, corners, straight or curved lines).

Use blocks, drawing, or paper folding to build and compare shapes and discuss what makes them the same or different.

Explore fractions by cutting food items like sandwiches, fruit, or pizza into halves, quarters, or eighths, and talk about equal parts.
