

Being a Class Ambassador

Each year we ask 1 or 2 parent/guardians, per class, to be Class Ambassadors. The Class Ambassador helps other parents, the class teacher and the Rangeview Parents & Friends (RP&F)

The role isn't very time consuming, but is very important for the children in your class, their parents, and the wider Rangeview Community.

The main role of the Class Ambassador is to encourage parent involvement in the school community. The Class Ambassador updates and sends out the contact details of families in each class to enable parents to be able to contact each other. (Forms asking for contact details are given to parents and collected by your class teacher – you will be asked to collate these to send to your class)

During the year Class Ambassadors are encouraged to organise catch-ups (either dinners or coffees etc). These opportunities to meet and get to know other parents are beneficial to everyone. They are particularly important for new families in Foundation, new families joining the school community throughout the year, as well as parents who work during the day.

Having a Class Ambassador also enables communication and organisation between the teachers and families in relation to classroom helpers and other activities, including excursions etc. The Class Ambassador will decide their best way of communication with their class, maybe email or text messages.

Throughout the year the Rangeview Parents and Friends facilitate social and fundraising events. Parents will be called upon to help out where/when they can and the Class Ambassador assists in this communication and seeking of assistance.

As a Class Ambassador, you will be able to give your permission for the Rangeview Parents and Friends to have your contact email address for ease of communication. Class Ambassadors are not expected to attend Parents and Friends meetings, although are more than welcome if they wish to.

If you think you would like to be a Class Ambassador for your child's class please let your Class Teacher know, or send the slip below to School with your child.

A Class Ambassadors meeting will be organised in the next few weeks to bring everyone together. At this meeting Liz Barr will talk a bit about what will be happening around the School this year and the Parents and Friends Committee will talk about some of the Social and Fundraising events happening in 2019.
