The Brimbank Council Neighbourhood Houses Unit (NHU) has been super busy supporting our communities with programs and working with others in a variety of initiatives to support Brimbank people to grow and flourish.

We are all hoping the recent COVID outbreak is short-lived and we encourage our community to continue to get tested if you have any symptoms, and get vaccinated as soon as you can. People over the age of 40 are now eligible to be vaccinated. For testing sites, go to

https://www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au/where-gettested-covid-19. We all play an important role in keeping our community safe during these uncertain times. Your local Community Centre or Neighbourhood House is a good place to get information about testing and vaccination.

Each year Neighbourhood House Victoria (NHVic) host awards to recognise and celebrate the valuable work of Neighbourhood Houses and Community Centres on a state-wide level. The five award categories correlate with several of the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals. These categories are Reducing Inequalities, Climate Action, Gender Equity, Social Enterprise, and Community Resilience.

This year, the winner of the Reducing Inequalities Award was our very own Sydenham Neighbourhood House's BRIMBANK LIVE, a digital radio platform supporting young people to connect and learn through media production in partnership with Making Media Australia. Participants receive training in writing, hosting and production of radio shows and podcasts. It is aimed at young people experiencing structural disadvantage, and allows them to unpack issues important to them, on their terms. Conceived during the pandemic as a way of supporting young people to feel connected, the platform provides opportunities to showcase the talents and experiences of young people in relation to mental health, gender and racial diversity, and career pathways.

Neighbourhood House Week 8-14 May 2021

Brimbank NHU celebrated the week with a pop-up Neighbourhood House at Derrimut Shopping Centre. This community engagement event provided opportunity for community members to discover and get a taste of activities offered at their local centre. Adults and seniors were able to join a creative floral art making session, whilst children walked away with an artistic balloon. Native hibiscus plants were provided as a give-away to raise awareness and encourage conversations about 'Sorry Day'. More than 50 families from Derrimut and surrounding areas were engaged, with most never having heard of a community centre/neighbourhood house before. Community members expressed interest in children's programs, Men's Shed, basic home maintenance and basic car maintenance programs. The event provided a way to take the temperature on the awareness of Neighbourhood Houses in the Derrimut community, and create ideas for outreach and programming.

Invest in You: Reducing Gambling Harm Project

The post COVID rush back to the pokies has hit Brimbank hard. In the past 4 months our community has spent 54 million on the machines, with up to a 25% increase in daily losses that peaked in February at \$482,169.00 per day. These are the highest losses ever recorded in Victoria and research tells us that between one-half and two-thirds of these are incurred by people experiencing harmful levels of gambling. The Victorian Responsible Gambling Foundation advises that people who play the pokies more than once a week, for more than 30 minutes at a time, may also be at risk of gambling harm.

The 'Invest in You' project is working with Brimbank communities to design gambling harm awareness raising campaigns and promote and provide alternatives to gambling. We look forward to showing you the outcomes during August and September.
