Our Beginner Music Program is a specially designed sequential program for children, that in addition to individual lessons, includes one session each term either with a piano accompanist or tuition in music theory.

When starting out, we suggest the following ages:

- · Strings 5 + years
- · Piano 5 + years
- · Wind and Brass 7 + years
- · Voice 6 + years

Students in our Beginner Music Programs also join one of our beginner string, wind, percussion or choral ensembles to support development, maintain motivation, and meet other students starting out on their musical journey.


Cantilena Singers - Years 3 - 6 Wednesdays 4:00 - 5:00pm

Beginner ensembles are FREE for students enrolled in the Beginner Music Program.


We also have a large library of instruments available for hire, including string instruments of varying sizes to suit students as they grow.
