Transport will be: By Bus or Private Transport if specified

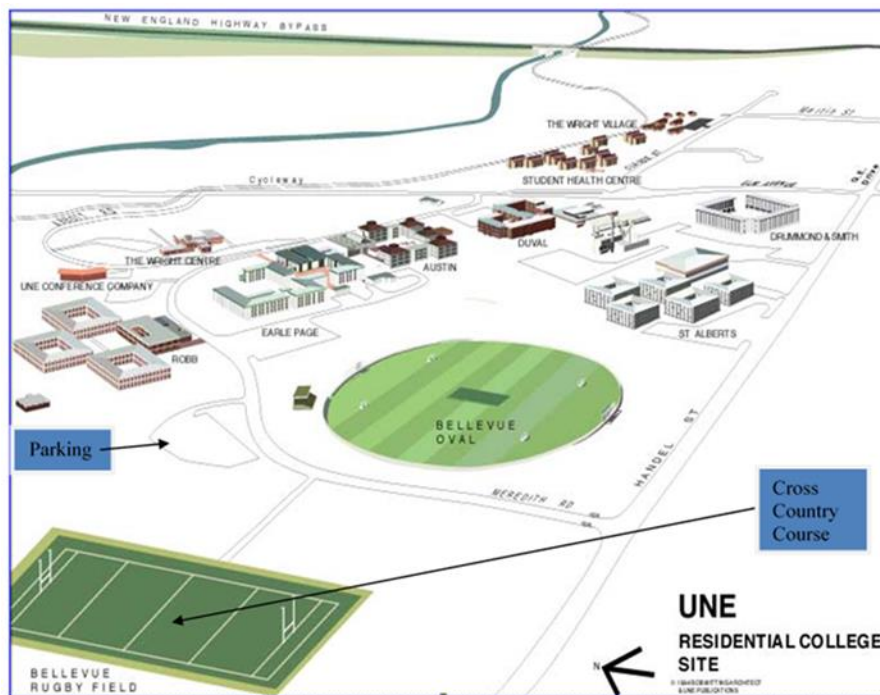
The group will be supervised by: Brad Hunt, Leah Miller and Georgia Brown.
