

The Garden: Train the Facilitator

Focus: Professionals working with fathers and male carers of children up to 4 years old

The Garden Therapeutic Group is one of a range of programs designed by Together4Kids. The Garden is designed for Infants and Toddlers aged 0-4 years accompanied by a parent. The Garden Group is an opportunity for shared positive experiences, to support the relationship between a parent and their child. Using a strong theoretical background, themes and activity ideas within the Garden program include exploration of natural environment, art, shared sensory activities, movement, play, relaxation and reflective opportunities.

In this two day training you will learn how to facilitate The Garden Program and will be provided with tips and advice on how to run an intentional group successfully. There will be time to practice some of the exercises and familiarise yourself with some of the sessions. The focus of these sessions is professionals working with fathers and male carers of children up to 4 years old.
