- Ministry Work: Implement Lasallian charisms and traditions in your ministry, focusing on building relationships with students and being a credible witness of faith.
- **Youth Engagement:** Provide pastoral care, facilitate retreats, and lead youth-oriented spiritual activities.

- Facilitation: Confidently present in front of a group on Catholic faith-related topics, including our Founder, St John Baptist de La Salle
- Administrative Support: Support major and local event coordination, communication, and logistics responsibilities.
