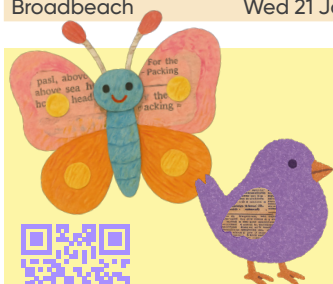
THE GREAT LINKTOPUS CHALLENGE
