On sport days, I wear my sport uniform.

Sports Uniform: All year

- Blue/Green polo shirt with St Finbar's Logo
- (short or long sleeved)
- Navy sports shorts or skorts
- Navy track pants
- Navy track top with St Finbar's Logo
- Sport runners (no high-tops or Vans)
- White socks



In Term 1 and Term 4, I wear my summer uniform.

Girls

- St Finbar's tartan dress (Navy, green and yellow check) or Unisex Navy Shorts and Blue Short sleeved shirt with logo
- St Finbar's school jumper (Navy V neck with yellow and green stripes at neck and cuffs)
- Black, polishable, school shoes and navy socks
- School Hat (legionnaire style)

Boys

- Navy Shorts
- Blue Short Sleeved shirt with logo
- St Finbar's School Jumper
- Black, polishable, school shoes and navy socks
- School Hat (legionnaire style)



In Term 2 and Term 3, I wear my winter uniform.

Girls

- St Finbar's Navy Tunic or Navy Trousers
- Girls Blue long sleeve Peter Pan collar shirt with Bow Tie
- St Finbar's school Jumper
- Black, polishable, school shoes and navy socks or tights

Boys

- Navy Trousers
- Boys Blue Long sleeved shirt with Tie
- St Finbar's School Jumper
- Black, polishable, school shoes and navy socks
- School scarf or beanie (optional)



OPTIONAL

- School scarf or beanie. These can be purchased from the uniform shop.
- Navy gloves
- Not to be worn in the classroom.



There are many accessories I can wear with my uniform.

Accessories

- Ribbons/ scrunchies/ headbands - must be Navy
- Jewellery:
 - A watch - All smart watches must be placed with the classroom teacher for the day.
 - Earrings - sleepers or studs only
 - A cross on a chain may also be worn.
- Year 6 rugby jumper may be worn by Year 6 students
- St. Finbar's School Bag
- Library Bag
- The following things aren't acceptable at school:
 - Nail polish
 - Brightly dyed hair colours



If I go to tennis with Ray, I wear the same uniform as the rest of my class.



If my class is wearing their school uniform, I need to change into my runners before my lesson with Ray and then change back into my school shoes once I go back to class.



If you have tryouts for a team with Mrs Allen or Mrs Thompson, they will let you know what uniform to wear.

When this happens, I need to speak with my parent or carer and they must email my teacher.
