E-scooters in Victoria

From 5 April 2024, we're extending the current trial for six months

e-scooter riders must


- Be aged 16 years and over
- Not ride at more than 20km/h
- Ride only on shared paths and roads that have a speed limit of up to 60km/h
- Always wear a helmet
- Follow traffic rules
- Be visible at all times

e-scooter riders <u>cannot</u>

- Ride on the footpath
- Use a mobile phone while riding
- Ride under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Carry passengers, animals or ride in tandem
- Ride a high-speed e-scooter, one capable of more than 25km/h
- Ride on roads that have a speed limit over 60km/h

Ride safe. E-scooters can only ride at a max speed of 20km/h

Ride safe. Drink, drug and mobile device laws apply to E-scooter riders
