Subjects include a mixture of sports and exercise science, sport coaching, talent identification, game development, sport management, human physiology, and anatomy subjects.

The program combines studies in a range of sport topics including management, marketing and media and is delivered at IKON Park, the home of the Carlton Football Club (six subjects) and the Melbourne campus of La Trobe University at Bundoora (two subjects).

Students who complete the Diploma of Elite Sport Business are able to proceed straight into the <u>second year</u> of a Bachelor of Business such as –

- Bachelor of Business
- Bachelor of Sport Management
