## ABOUT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students selected for this scholarship program will participate in a dedicated 90 minute weekly session as part of a group of 8-10 students from years 4-6. Sessions will run after lunch and will alternate between campuses. Transportation for students will be provided as required. We expect this scholarship group will at times go off site to experience photography in a variety of settings.

This program will be led by an experienced photographer. This scholarship Program will help students build their capacity to take quality photos and to use technology to edit photos.

For this scholarship program, we're looking for students with a passion for photography. Participation will require a commitment to practising learnt skills out of school.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrated commitment to the school's values (Respectful, Responsible and Kind)
- A demonstrated passion for photography.
- Demonstrated capability in the photography.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with others.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Students currently in grades 3, 4 and 5 are now invited to apply for a spot in the 2024 Photography Scholarship Program. Students from both campuses are invited to apply. The closing date for applications is Friday December 1st. To apply, students need to write a letter explaining why they would like to be participate and why they should be selected. Whilst students can apply for more than 1 scholarship program, they can only be selected for 1.

Students are also be invited to include extra documents that demonstrate their interest and capabilities in photography.

Please submit applications to the office staff. We do expect each of the scholarship programs will be over-subscribed, so it's likely we'll organise an interview with each application to ensure the best candidates are chosen.
