Covid School Guidelines Term 1 2021

For the health and safety of everyone at Sacred Heart School all visitors must follow the important Guidelines as directed by DHHS Vic and CECV.

- Parents may enter the school grounds to drop off/pick up their child/children.
- Ensure physical distancing (1.5 metres) at all times.
- Visitors over the age of 12 must wear a face mask when it is not possible to keep 1.5 metres distance from others.
- Practice good hand hygiene.
- Do not come onto the school premises if you or anyone in your family is unwell.
- Avoid all interactions in close spaces.
- Families should limit their time onsite to less than 15 minutes at any given time.
- Any visitors must sign in or scan the QR code if onsite for more than 15 minutes.
- Safety requirements in the office allow for a maximum of two visitors at a given time.
- To ensure consistency with physical distancing measures, students and families will not be permitted to congregate at the school gate before or after school.
- Adults are asked to reduce congestion around the school at all times by using the various entry/exit points and not congregating.

School Events

- Visitor records must be kept.
- Outdoor events can take place. Visitors may attend with density limits of 1 person per 2 square metres.
- It is no longer required to reduce mixing amongst different year levels.
- Assemblies and Liturgies can take place density limits apply for external visitors
- Excursions, incursions and school camps can resume.
- Music can be performed indoor and outdoor.
- Sporting activities, including interschool sports can resume. Density limits of one person per two square metres should be applied to spectator areas when parents or other guests are in attendance.
- All visitors must practice good hand hygiene.
- Visitors must not be on school premises if they or anyone in their family is unwell.
