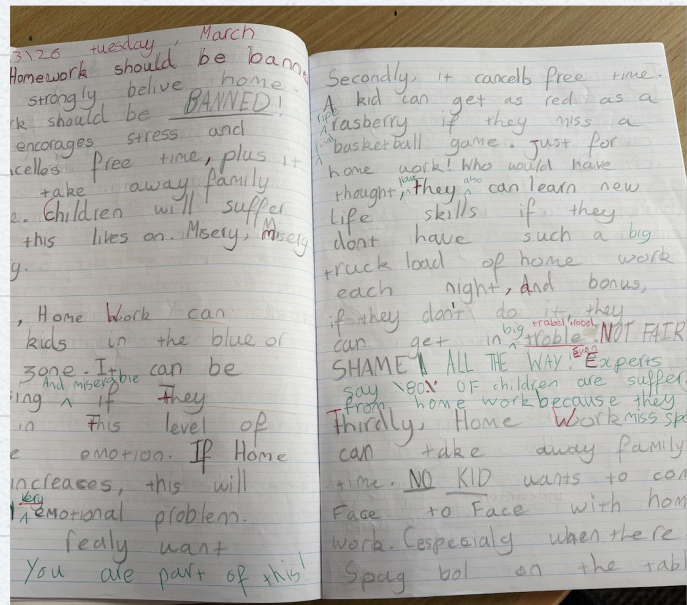

Additionally, all year three classes have been visiting the library on a weekly basis, giving student the opportunity to explore new books and borrow for independent reading!



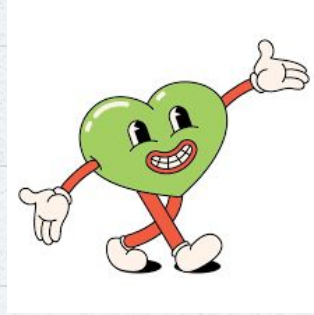








# CLOSING
