

Semester One Examinations (Year 10 – 12)

The examinations for students in the Senior School will commence on Monday May 23rd and will be conducted in the Cappenburg classrooms unless otherwise specified. Students are also reminded of the following expectations:

1. All ATAR Pathway (Year 11 & 12) are required to attend the College for their examinations only.
2. All Vocational / General Pathway (Year 11 & 12) students will continue attend their regular scheduled classes.
3. All Year 10 students are required to attend the College for their examinations only.

If a student is absent from an examination due to illness or an injury-related matter, and is unable to attend complete an examination, the College must be notified as soon as possible. Please note that a medical certificate is required for any medical related absence from an examination. Student expectations:

1. All examination candidates should aim to arrive at least twenty (20) minutes before the commencement of their examination (*i.e.*, 8:30am or 12:30pm), and students in Year 10 should note that they are not required to attend Homeroom prior to an examination.
2. All (Year 10 & 11) candidates are required to present their **Purple Card** at the examination, and display the card on their desk for the duration of the examination – for Year 12 ATAR examinations, only SCSA-approved provisions will be able to be accessed.
3. All Candidates **MUST** attend the examination wearing the appropriate College (Winter) Uniform, and a student may be excluded from the examination if they fail to adhere to College expectations for uniform and personal presentation.
4. All bags must be placed in a student's locker and are not allowed in the examination venue, including the Cappenburg Foyer.
5. Hand sanitiser will be available and students should adhere to the appropriate health and hygiene protocols.
6. Students must remain silent when they enter and exit the examination venue and must ensure that they provide the required materials including:
 - a. A clear plastic sleeve for pens, pencils and other approved items.
 - b. Approved materials (*i.e.*: calculators & notes) for Mathematics examinations must be confirmed with the Head of Mathematics.
 - c. Mathematics notes are not to be folded, creased or glued together.
 - d. A student is *typically* permitted two A4 (doubled sided) sheets as a maximum.
7. Please ensure that all drink bottles are clear, plastic bottles with all labels removed – only water is allowed in drink bottles.
8. Mobile phones will **NOT** be permitted under any circumstances, and any student with a mobile phone must turn the phone off and place it in their locker or the box provided by in the Cappenburg Foyer.
9. **Candidates must REMOVE ALL WATCHES before they enter the examination venue.**
