

Prep Term 1 Newsletter 2025

A warm welcome to all parents and families to Prep 2025. There are many exciting events that happen in Term 1, within our school community. Thank you for helping to make the children's transition into school happy and positive. We look forward to working together throughout the year.

Literacy

In Reading we use an evidence based phonics program. The children learn about the connection between letters and sounds in both speech and writing. The writing program will be connected to reading with students learning letter formation at the same time as they are exposed to the letter name and sound. They are also exposed to a variety of books and will learn about vocabulary and comprehension.



Reading at Home

Children will bring home a reading diary. This term you will be reading to your child and they will draw a picture of what they have listened to. Some weeks they will also revise letter formation. Each term will have a different diary. When the students start bringing home books they will be reading decodable texts that match the teaching in class.



Mathematics

We will begin the term learning about patterns, with an emphasis on two and three part patterns. The children will then learn about time - they will be ordering events, learning the days of the week and ordering events in books. The Counting and Place Value Unit will cover reading and writing numerals, matching and counting collections and adding up to 10, counting forwards and backwards from any starting point and making. The final unit is Location and the children will describe the positions of objects.

Religion

We will begin the year with a focus on, 'Praying to Jesus/God'. In this unit students learn about prayer as talking to and listening to God. They are introduced to the prayer space and the objects and symbols that make up this space. They learn some of the behaviours and actions of prayer, including making the Sign of the Cross. In this unit students are also introduced to the image of Jesus Christ. We will then continue the term with the unit, 'Following Jesus, Loving and Serving'. In this unit, we will explore the parable of The Lost Sheep and learn about the Lenten season and Holy Week.



Health and Safety unit

Students will begin the year with the topic, 'How Can I Be The Best Me?' Within this unit we will discuss what rules and responsibilities are and how we can keep ourselves safe at school. Students will learn about the importance of keeping their bodies healthy with a focus on healthy eating and physical activity. Students will also be participating in mindful activities and meditation.

Parent parking

Just a reminder that the school carpark is only to be used by school staff members. The front of the school is **strictly a 2 minute** pick-up zone. Parking inspectors visit frequently and have a camera in the back of the car as they drive past. They **will issue fines**, many parents were fined in 2024. If there are no parks in the bay please do another lap around the block. Parking is available on side streets however please be mindful of the neighbour's driveways.
