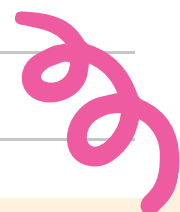


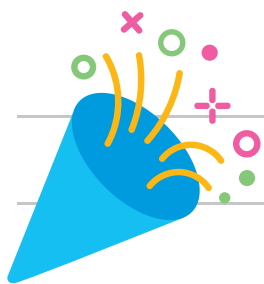


# Children's Feedback

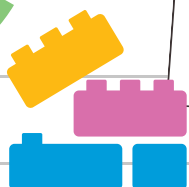
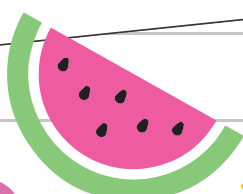
