

Parent Checklist

What you can do at home to help your child

- Ensure your child has all the books, IT equipment and supplies they require
- Provide a quiet environment to complete homework and study
- Check your child's timetable on Compass and support them in planning their days and weeks, eg. PE and subjects that require specific equipment
- Have a conversation with your child to ensure all assessment tasks are completed and submitted on time
- Check that your child is recording homework for each class they have, every day (even if they sometimes write No Homework or NH)
- Check that your child is reviewing their Cornell Notes, writing questions and a summary every day (about 5 minutes work for each class).
- Make sure your child eats breakfast and brings lunch
- Ensure the school has all your relevant contact information and update the school when necessary
- Encourage your child to practice good organisational skills
- Make sure your child is at school on time and notify the school if they are absent or late
- Ensure your child is always in full school uniform
- Encourage your child to participate in sport and other extra-curricular activities
- Read the school newsletters and Compass News Feeds
- Support the school by allowing your child to attend excursions and events
- Contact the school immediately if financial constraints are affecting your child's opportunity to learn so the appropriate action can be taken
- Keep the lines of communication open with your child and the school so any issues are dealt with quickly and effectively
