## RULES FOR EXAM PROCEDURE

- Exams will be held in the auditorium.
- Teachers will notify you of the exact length of each examination.
- You need to be lined up quietly outside the entry to the foyer of the Café / auditorium 5 minutes before the exam is due to start with all your equipment (your subject teachers and exam specifications document will advise you as to what you need to bring to each exam).
- **No pencil cases** are allowed in the exam rooms and there is to be no borrowing of equipment once in the room.
- **No food** is allowed in the exam rooms.
- **Water** must be in a clear plastic bottle that has no adhesive labels (stickers) and has a secure lid. The bottle can be a maximum of 1500 ml capacity. No other drinks are allowed into the exam room. You are not allowed to refill your water bottle during the exam or share it with other students.
- **No-one** will be allowed in the exam room once the exam has started. If you are late, you will need to go to the school Office and arrange to meet with Mr. Barker; your exam may be rescheduled.
- Students will enter and leave the room together; there is to be **no communicating** once you are in the exam room. If you need to get a teacher's attention, raise your hand and wait for them to come to you.
- No bathroom use will be allowed in the first or last fifteen minutes.
- **No electronic devices (Mobile phone, Smart watches etc).**
- Each exam will begin with a prayer and some exams will include 10 minutes reading time. During this time, you may write on your exam paper but may not commence writing in your booklet. You will be told when you can begin writing and when to stop writing.
- All exams should be written in blue or black pen unless your teacher allows other writing implements.
- Any communication or attempt to communicate between students will be regarded as cheating. Cheating will result in the removal of the student's examination paper, an instant result of zero, and removal from the exam room.
- When you finish your examination you will need to sit quietly until the full time is up and make sure you have fully checked over your examination paper. You may draw or write in the back of your booklet, or the teachers may provide scrap paper.
