CURRICULUM OVERVIEWS:

ENGLISH

- Reading: continuing our class novel study of Two Wolves, Literature Circles meetings and roles (Stella Summariser, Literary Luminary, Connector, Illustrator/Mapper, Discussion Director, Word Wizard), efficient note taking strategies from digital and text literacy sources, inferential and evaluative text responses
- Writing: persuasive writing (expositions), debate planning, poetry, NAPLAN preparation, individualised spelling, editing and proofreading, grammar.
- Speaking and Listening: debating practise and presentation night, 1 minute talks on researched topics

MATHS

- Number and Algebra: multiplication and division (with and without remainders), factors and multiples, revision of addition/subtraction
- Measurement and Geometry: exploring length, mass, capacity, volume, perimeter, area. Looking at converting and comparing 12 and 24 hour time.
- NAPLAN preparation

INTEGRATED INQUIRY LEARNING

Students will explore the question of how we celebrate
where we come from, who we are and where we're
heading together. Throughout the unit students will
look at how Australian History was shaped by key
events (including Indigenous Australians), reflect on
how different cultures have contributed and shaped
Australia, the Gold Rush in the 1800s and the
importance of celebrating differences
