Event 10: Novelties – Golf ball race

Event 11: Activity course

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Team Managers are responsible for their own team members and are the point of contact for any enquiries. **It is essential that we have a mobile phone contact number & email address for every team.**
2. Every entry must include a nominated helper. The nominated helper must perform designated duty or corresponding entry team, or individuals may be eliminated. One helper MUST be provided per team or per entry if entering individually.
3. Entries will not be accepted **WITHOUT PROOF OF PAYMENT**
4. Copies of PCV/EA membership cards and day attendance forms/payments for non PCV/EA members must be sent with the entry form. One entry form per rider with the team listed. **Entry fee is \$45 per PC rider, \$45 + \$20 day attendance per Open rider.**
5. \$20 Day Attendance fee is due unless you **HAVE PROOF** that you are a **CURRENT** member of PCV; EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA, HRC and Interstate PC; or can prove personal liability cover of at least \$1,000,000.
6. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover must **complete the Day Participant Waiver.** PCV Insurance Policy specifically states that anyone not following PCV rules may be left uninsured.
7. PCV alcohol policy applies
8. **Refunds will only be given with a doctor's or Vet's certificate. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from each scratching refunded. No refunds unless notified within 7 days of the conclusion of the event.**
9. The Organizers reserve the right to query & possibly disqualify any non PCV rider who is wrongly graded or incapable of riding safely.
10. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, rider, ground spectators or any other person or property.
11. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

RULES OF COMPETITION.

12. All riders are to be in school uniform with neutral coloured or solid black or navy-blue jodhpurs/moleskins, smooth sole boots, and helmets as per PCA National Gear Rules 2026. Western style boots are permitted but must be worn UNDER the jodhpurs/moleskins. Uniform is to be worn during the events and at presentations. Suede chaps/chapettes are not permitted
13. **All riders must present for a gear check prior to commencement of riding.** Gear check will follow the PCA National Gear Rules 2026.
14. **Show jumping heights offered – beginner cross rails & A-G Grades.**
15. **Competitors must nominate which Grade they will compete in** – no transferring of grades will be permitted on the day.
16. Beginner cross rails will be held for ungraded primary/pre-school riders only.
17. All show jumping competitors are required to walk the course prior to the event and if not capable/ competent to cope with the specification and conditions, withdraw from the competition – no substitution to a replacement event will be permitted.
18. Events 1-4 will be at the judge's discretion; final competitors' may be required to complete a workout. Event 4 at the judge's discretion may include some obstacles/jump etc.
19. Event 11 will be a timed course with set activities. No whips or spurs permitted in novelty events.

20. Entrants compete as individuals and if not entered in a team of 4, will be placed in a composite team by the organising committee. Each competitor to ride the same mount for all events. One rider may compete on two separate mounts as two separate entries.

21. This is a **team competition**. The aim of this competition is to have fun riding with your school team members and to get to know riders from different schools. Sashes & prizes for the top six teams.

Teams of three or four, with **best 3** scores to count.

Primary/pre-school students will compete separately to Secondary school students. Separate classes, ribbons and team sashes will be awarded.

Individual ribbons to 6th place in each event will be given out during the event Events 1-3 or at presentation, Events 4-10.

22. SCORING

Points will be allocated to individuals placed in events as follows:

1 st	10 points	6 th	5 points
2 nd	9 points	7 th	4 points
3 rd	8 points	8 th	3 points
4 th	7 points	9 th	2 points
5 th	6 points	10 th	1 point

All riders placing below 10th place will get 1 point for competing in that event.
