We can help eligible clients with a “Disability” from the age of 14 to the Age Pension qualifying age, both a physical limitation and a mental illness affecting the person’s life, such as – but not limited to:

- Mental Illness (e.g. Depression, Anxiety)
- Post Traumatic Disorder (PST)
- Speech Disorder
- Insomnia
- Migraine
- Eating Disorder
- Amnesia – Loss of Memory (Temporary)
- Digestive System
- Chronic Anaemia
- Diabetes
- Cancer
- Stroke
- Carpal tunnel syndrome (CTS)
- Immune System Disorders (e.g. Chronic Fatigue, Arthritis)
- Skin condition (e.g. Psoriasis, Dermatitis, Burns)
- Addition (e.g. Drug and Alcohol dependency)
- Neurological (e.g. Multiple Sclerosis, Epilepsy)
- Cardiovascular Disorder (e.g. heart issues)
- Respiratory Disorder (e.g. Asthma)
- Gynaecological Problems
- Spine Injuries/disorders (e.g. herniated disc, Lordosis, Lordosis)
