The life Jesus gives is eternal—Nourished by the bread of life -John 6:51-58

In this passage, Jesus reveals the depth of His love and sacrifice. The "living bread" represents His very life, freely given for the salvation of humanity. By inviting us to partake in this bread, Jesus in not only calling us to believe in Him but to enter into an intimate, life-giving relationship with him. The imagery of eating His flesh and drinking His blood is startling and powerful. It emphasises the necessity of embracing the fullness of Christ's sacrifice, internalising His teachings, and living in union with Him. This passage also points to the Eucharist, where believers partake of Christ in a tangible, sacramental way, uniting us more deeply with him and with one another. Ultimately, this reflection invites us to consider the transformative power of Christ's presence in our lives. By receiving Him, we are not only nourished spiritually but also drawn into eternal life, a life that begins here and now through our communion with Him.

Lord Jesus, You are the living bread that came down from heaven. Nourish our souls with Your presence and fill our hearts with Your love. As we partake in Your body and blood, help us to live in union with You and one another. May we be strengthened by Your grace to follow You faithfully and share Your life-giving love with the world. Amen

#### First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6

Wisdom has built herself a house, she has erected her seven pillars, she has slaughtered her beasts, prepared her wine, she has laid her table.

She has despatched her maidservants and proclaimed from the city's heights: 'Who is ignorant? Let him step this way.'

To the fool she says, 'Come and eat my bread, drink the wine I have prepared!

Leave your folly and you will live, walk in the ways of perception.'

#### Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20

Be very careful about the sort of lives you lead, like intelligent and not like senseless people. This may be a wicked age, but your lives should redeem it. And do not be thoughtless but recognise what is the will of the Lord. Do not drug yourselves with wine, this is simply dissipation; be filled with the Spirit. Sing the words and tunes of the psalms and hymns when you are together, and go on singing and chanting to the Lord in your hearts, so that always and everywhere you are giving thanks to God who is our Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Gospel: John 6:51-58

Jesus said to the crowd:

'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.'

Then the Jews started arguing with one another: 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' they said. Jesus replied:

'I tell you most solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life in you. Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood lives in me and I live in him.

As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me. This is the bread come down from heaven; not like the bread our ancestors ate: they are dead, but anyone who eats this bread will live for ever.'

This month we look forward to your company at our Movie and Shared Lunch Day in the Parish Theatre




