Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: World Challenge - 2 Day Training Expedition

Our Practice Expedition is on Friday 22nd March & Saturday 23rd March at Gembrook. The girls will meet an Expedition Leader and run through Expedition Scenarios. They will learn about: Preparing Meals; Teamwork & Leadership; Staying Healthy; Staying Safe and Tents and Camp craft.

The girls have been sent a Kit List for the Training Expedition only. They will need "well-worn boots", waterproofs and warm layers. It's important that they borrow what they can, maybe purchase equipment/ clothing off past World Challengers and enjoy finding out what items work for them and their destination. The girls will be able to borrow Kilbreda school packs for the Training Expedition only. These will be given out on Wednesday 20th March. If they have already purchased their pack, we suggest they start using this pack to get used to it and its functions.

The food will be provided for the girls by World Challenge on the Training Expedition. These meals will be prepared by the team and serve as examples of what they may make in country.
