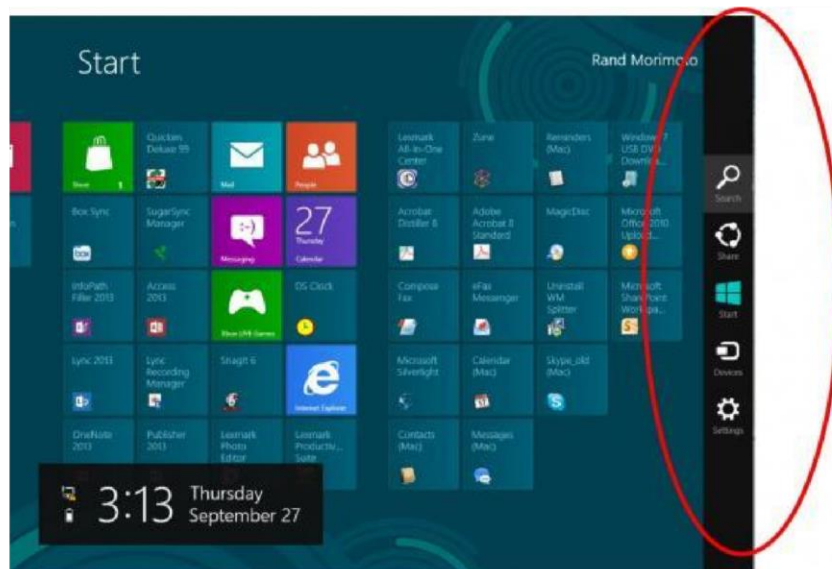




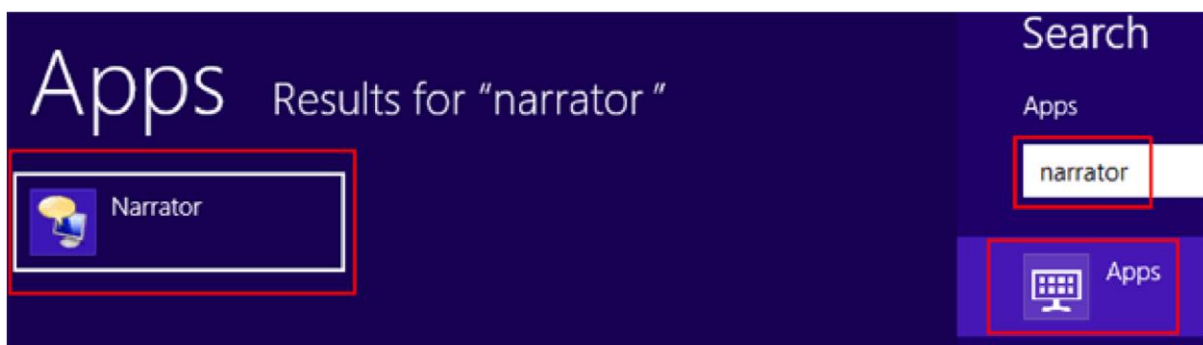
SETTING UP WINDOWS 8 NARRATOR FOR TEXT-TO-SPEECH

Turning on Windows 8/8.1 Narrator

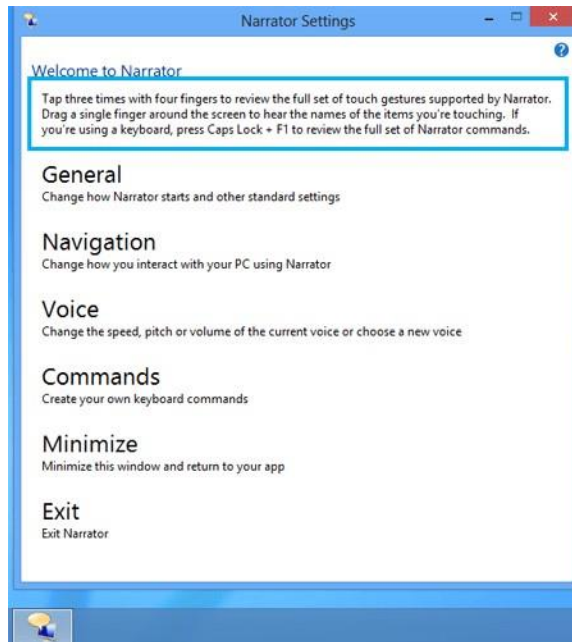
1. **Go to the Start Screen** by pressing the **Windows button** on the screen at the bottom left of the desktop or by pressing the **Windows key on the keyboard** or alternatively by pressing the **physical Windows button on the face of the Tablet**.
2. **Swipe left from the right most side** to bring up the charms menu. Alternatively, move the mouse to the **bottom right corner** to reveal the charms menu.



3. Press the **Search charm** either by tapping it on the screen or clicking on it using the mouse.
4. **Click on the Search bar** and type in **Narrator**. Click on the **Narrator Icon** that appears.



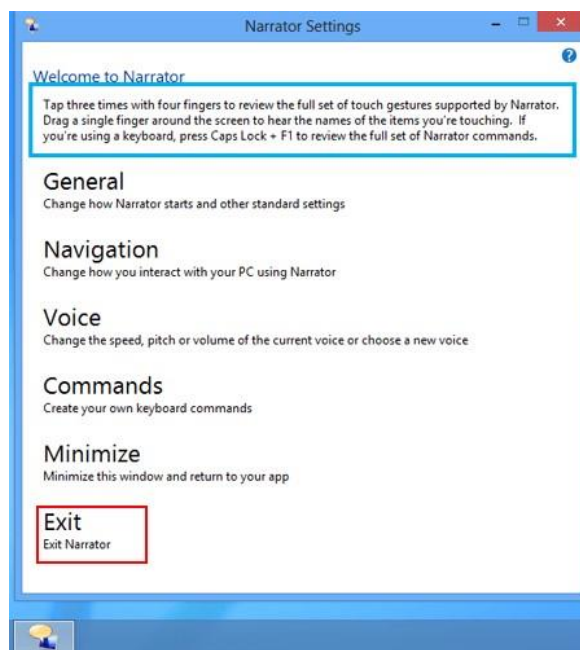
5. You will now see the following Screen...



6. After turning on Windows 8 Narrator, you are capable of making changes to its settings such as voice, navigation, commands, etc. More specifically speaking, on the desktop, you can click Narrator icon on the left of task bar to open Narrator Settings window, and then make changes to Voice, Navigation and other settings in it. In the Voice settings, you can change the voice to Australian English.
7. Use Windows 8/8.1 with the assistance of the Narrator.

Turning off Windows 8/8.1 Narrator

1. Open **Narrator Settings** using the instructions above.
2. When you are in the **Settings** screen, press the **Exit** button.



3. When it asks to you confirm the exit, press **Yes**.
