JPPS Kids Disco – FAQs

Who is hosting the Kids Disco?

- The disco will be hosted and supervised by the Jells Park Parent Committee (JPPC).
- All committee members have children at the school and hold a current Working with Children Check.

What's the purpose of the disco?

- The disco is all about fun!
- It's also a fundraiser to help purchase new equipment for the school, such as art supplies.

Will any school staff be attending?

• Some school staff may be onsite on the night, but will not be involved in running the event.

How can I purchase tickets?

- Tickets must be purchased in advance via Qkr.
- Sales will close at 4.00pm on the day of the disco.
- NO tickets will be available at the door.

Why do I need to put my contact details in Qkr and who will have access to them?

- Your contact details are required in case we need to contact you on the night.
- We will uphold your Privacy at all times and ensure that only a couple of JPPC members have access to your information.

How will I identify JPPC members on the night?

- JPPC members will be wearing pink high-vis vests.
- We're happy to answer any questions on the night (although we'll be quite busy!).
- Alternatively, feel free to email us beforehand at parentcommittee@jpps.vic.edu.au.

Can I stay during the disco?

- Unfortunately, no.
- Parents are not permitted inside the gym or foyer during the disco.
- If your child may struggle without you, this might not be the best event for them.

What is the drop-off process?

- Parents will escort their child into the gym foyer.
- Your child's name will be checked off, and goodbyes will be said in the foyer.
- For safety, no parents will be allowed into the disco area.
- We recommend preparing your child by explaining this process in advance.

What is the pick-up process?

• Parents will line up along the outside wall of the gym along Homestead Drive.

- After the disco ends, you'll enter via the side door to collect your child and exit through the main doors.
- We've added extra lighting this year to improve visibility and safety.
- Clear signage will guide you, and JPPC members will be there to help.

Can I pick my child up early?

- We kindly ask that children stay for the entire session.
- If you really have to leave early, please let a JPPC member know when you sign your child in.

What happens if my child becomes upset or unwell during the session?

- We'll do our best to make them feel safe and happy.
- If they are unwell, we will contact you to come and collect them.

Why are the session times a bit shorter than last year?

• Last year's sessions proved too long for many younger children. This year, we've shortened them to better suit their energy levels.

Will food and drinks be provided?

- Yes! We'll provide cordial and water
- Lolly bags will also be available for purchase from the outside canteen window before the disco

Can my child bring their own food?

- No outside food is permitted.
- Water bottles are fine to bring.

Where can I purchase lollies and glow accessories?

- Before each session, Level 6 JP Racing Team members will be selling lollies, glow bands & other glow in the dark accessories from the canteen.
- Sales will take place at the external canteen window, with cash and card accepted (but PLEASE BRING CASH as it's much easier)
- Funds raised will support the JP Racing Team.

How do I let you know about my child's medical needs?

• When purchasing tickets via Qkr, there will be a section to note medical conditions, allergies, or any other special requirements.

What are the emergency procedures?

• Several JPPC members are first aid qualified. In the case of an emergency you will be contacted by the details provided on Qkr when booking your child's ticket.

I have children in both sessions—can they attend together?

- Unfortunately, no. Children from the first session must be collected at the end of their session and must leave with their parent / guardian.
- Children for the second session will not be allowed into the gym until it officially opens.

• Please do not leave children unsupervised on school grounds.

Can I get a refund if my child is sick on the night?

• Unfortunately, refunds are not available.
