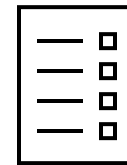
Open Day Dates

Register for the open day. Click the registration link on the open day website and fill out the online form.



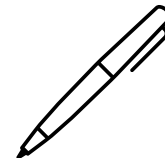
Step 2

EXAMPLES OF QUESTIONS TO ASK

What makes the courses I'm interested in different from similar courses at other institutes?

Tell me about the lecturers in the courses I'm interested in. What do they specialise in and what projects or research are they working on?

Can I do research or internships while studying here? How does the university help students find these opportunities?

How many students are there for each teacher? Are the teachers easy to reach outside of class if I need help or advice?

What kind of help does the university offer for finding jobs or internships after graduation?

Can you tell me how successful graduates are in getting jobs in the field I want to study?

Can I go to another country to study for a while? How does the university help students who want to study abroad?

What kind of things can I use on campus, like libraries, labs, computers, or special equipment?

How does the university help students with things like choosing classes, getting counselling, or getting help if I have a disability?

Are there clubs or groups for things I'm interested in?

What kinds of activities can I do outside of class?

What's the vibe like on campus? Are there any fun events, traditions, or things that make this university special?
