Filming instructions:

If you follow these simple steps, you'll look like a movie star!

• YOU MUST FILM THE VIDEO IN LANDSCAPE (with the phone on it's side)



- Ensure you're in the centre of the shot and look into the camera when speaking
- Try to keep the phone at eye-level (this will ensure you get the most flattering angle of yourself)
- Try to record in a **quiet** area with lots of **natural light**.



- Use the rear camera on your phone if possible
- Once you hit the record button, take a deep breath, relax, smile and begin speaking
