# The Australian Colonies \*\*HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS\*\*

#### **WEEKLY TASKS:**

Each week, students will have a selection of tasks to complete as homework.

There is an **Inquiry** focus, a **Maths** focus and an **English** focus.

#### **INQUIRY:**

This term's Inquiry homework is based on researching the <u>Australian Colonies - History & Change.</u> Each week you will complete a section of a timeline over the period of 1800- 1920. At the end of term, each section will be joined together (at school) to form a timeline from 1800 - 1920. These will be on display in the senior gallery area.

The requirements of each timeline are:

- A minimum of 5 facts, including interesting dates and information
- These dates may include significant individuals (birth date, place of birth etc.)
- Who came to Australia and why did they come?
- Significant Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander figures and/or events.

These timelines must include at least one picture (drawn and / or printed) and written information.

#### MATHS:

Each week you will be provided with a range of Multiplication and Division Challenges. You will need to time yourself completing the whole task.

EXTRA CHALLENGE: try to beat last week's time!

### **ENGLISH:**

<u>Reading</u> - ensure you are reading regularly, preferably on a daily basis. You can record your reading pages on the Reading Log each week.

<u>Spelling</u> - **Select 5** words from your personal writing for you to focus on each week. Complete LSCWC on each word and place them into sentences on the week's page. You may complete a spelling test with a family member.
