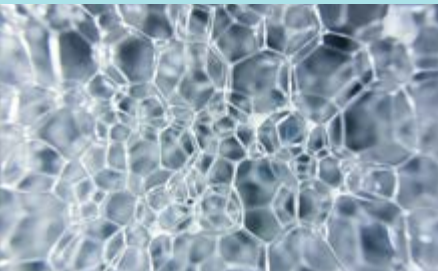

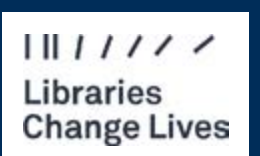

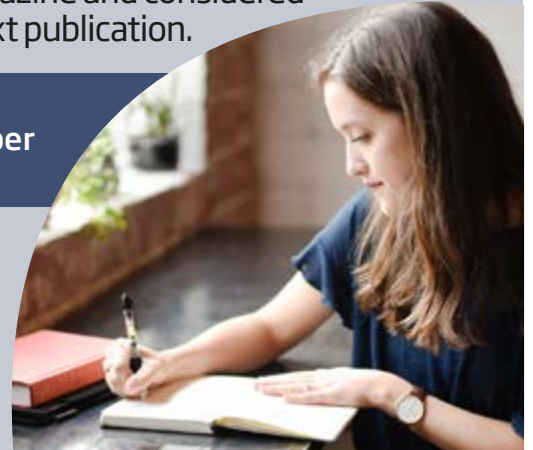


## Writing Workshop, What's on your mind? Zoom Webinar

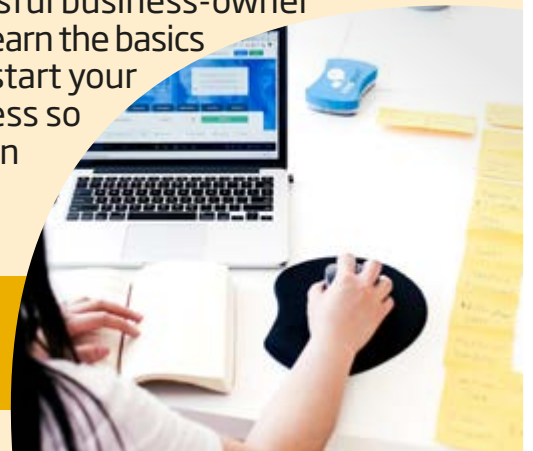
