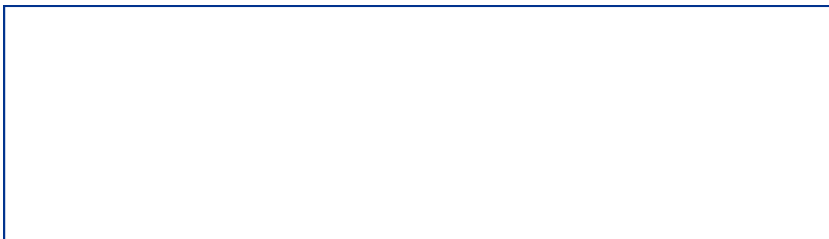

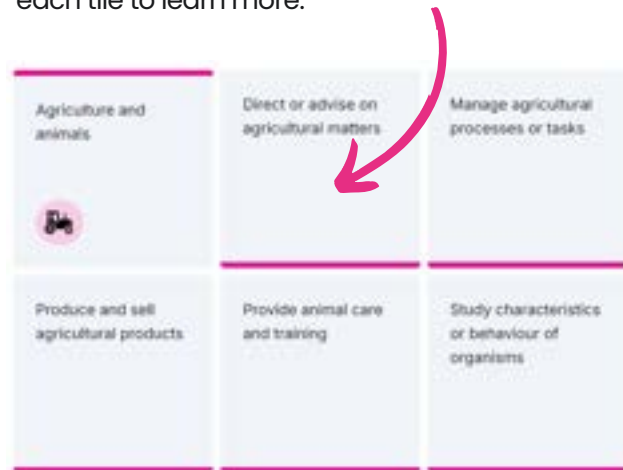


The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing industry involves activities like:

- Growing crops.
- Raising animals.
- Growing and harvesting timber.
- harvesting fish and other animals from farms or their natural habitats.

A large share of the workforce is employed in regional Australia.

Some of the top employing occupations in the The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing industry include Livestock Farmers, Crop Farmers, Farm Workers, and Agricultural, Forestry and Horticultural Plant Operators. Occupations across the industry share similar skill sets under the Australian Skills Classification. You can explore what these skills involve by clicking on each tile to learn more.



Agricultural, Forestry and Horticultural Plant Operators



What skills and strengths are needed?

A good understanding of machinery operation and basic maintenance. Precision and attention to detail for tasks like planting and harvesting which require accuracy. Physical stamina to handle long hours, often in varying weather conditions. Problem-solving abilities to quickly address equipment issues to minimise downtime, and strict adherence to safety measures.

What are Agricultural, Forestry and Horticultural Plant Operators?

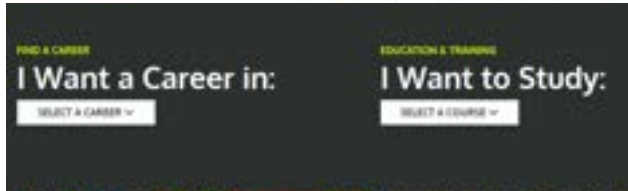
Envision yourself at the helm of powerful machines, working the land that feeds nations. Agricultural, Forestry and Horticultural Plant Operators are crucial in modern farming, skillfully handling machinery like tractors, harvesters, and ploughs to cultivate, sow, and harvest crops.

What are the pathways?

You can work as an Agricultural and Forestry Plant Operator without formal qualifications, however, a Certificate III in Rural Machinery Operations may be useful. Other VET courses in Agriculture or Agricultural Mechanics offer practical skills and knowledge combined with hands-on experience. You may also require specific licences depending on the machinery you're operating.
