Playing Safely



We are **Thinkers** when we think before we act and think before we speak.

We show we are **Balanced** when we are organised.

different people and learning different types of games.



We show we are **Knowledgeable** when we know
and practice ways to play safely, avoiding tackling and rough play.

Being Responsible



We are **Caring** when we care for the environment by keeping the playground clean. We avoid climbing trees and playing in the gardens.



We show we are **Open-minded** when we are open to another person's idea.

Being Responsible



We are **Principled** when we avoid playing along the fence line, behind buildings or playing with sticks. We play fairly and take our turns. We show our integrity by looking after equipment and returning it to its correct place.



We show we are **Risk-takers** when we share our ideas and are brave enough to try new games and activities. We offer to help others.

Showing Respect



We are **Communicators** when we talk and listen to others, sharing our thoughts, stories and perspectives. We talk to each other respectfully in order to solve problems in the playground. We know we can always ask a yard duty teacher for assistance.



We show we are **Caring**, when we are friendly, including others in our games and treating each other with respect through our words and actions. We share equipment and court space.

We are **Inquirers** when we ask questions about our playground activities. We can teach others new games and explore different areas of the playground. We know where we can play ball games and where we can spend time quietly with our friends.
