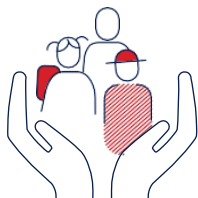


What is *Learning for Life*?

The *Learning for Life* program works in partnership with families to support their children's education and increase their chances of success at school.

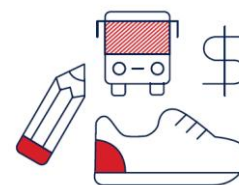
Learning for Life provides:



Support from a dedicated Family Partnership Coordinator

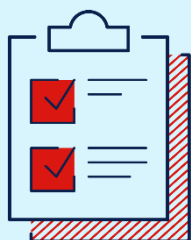


Access to educational programs for the whole family

Am I eligible for *Learning for Life*?



To be eligible, you must:

- ✓ Have a Health Care or Pension Concession Card
- ✓ Have a child in a primary school we work with
- ✓ Support your child to attend school regularly

What else do I need to know?

Learning for Life is a partnership between your family and The Smith Family.

As a parent, guardian, or caregiver, you need to commit to:

- Regular school attendance
- Completing a yearly update for each child
- Providing a school report yearly for each child
- Maintaining contact with The Smith Family
