A HISTORY OF THE WOMEN'S MOVEMENT IN AUSTRALIA

This unit examines key campaigns of the women's movement, including the right to vote, equal pay, reproductive rights, countering violence and sexual assault, and rights in the workplace.

INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' STRUGGLES FOR JUSTICE

We look at the struggle of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples for rights and freedoms, including the Land Rights movement, the stolen generations and Black Lives Matter.
