Pope John Paul II – QF 161 - Perth to Rome on 1/12/1986

Seeking assistance with memorabilia!

This November it will be 40 years since Pope John Paul II spent 10 days in Australia. On November 28th, 1986, he spent the morning at St Leo's Church and School in Altona North. Now, St Leo's Parish is wanting to set up a museum to commemorate that important visit. I have only recently become aware that QANTAS printed four specific items for the flight which took the Pope back to Rome (via Seychelles) on 1/12/1986:

- Flight Arrangement booklet for staff use (gold cover).
- Menu card (dark brown cover).
- Note pad (purple cover).
- Inflight magazine/brochure (white cover).

All four items have the Pope's crest above the word QANTAS on the front cover.

The QANTAS "jet base museum" at Sydney airport has been extremely helpful, however St Leo's is hoping to put together a complete set of original documents.
