Notice of upcoming works - Rosebank Avenue, Clayton South

From Monday 30 June, we'll be undertaking work to increase safety and connectivity along Rosebank Avenue, Clayton South.

The works include:

- Construction of two flat-top speed humps at 102 and 128 Rosebank Avenue.
- Converting the existing zebra crossing outside the shops (150 Rosebank Avenue) to a raised flat-top speed hump crossing.
- Making the children's crossing outside the school safer by building out the kerb and making a zebra crossing.
- Installing a light pole and constructing a footpath and pram crossing at 77 Rosebank Avenue.
- Finishing off with line marking and signage.

Construction details

Works are due to commence on Monday, 30 June 2025, and are expected to be complete by August 2025.

During works, there may be short-term parking restrictions and at times, some traffic delays can be expected.

Contractors may need to utilise some nature strips and footpaths to store construction materials/portable buildings. The construction site will be maintained at all times.
