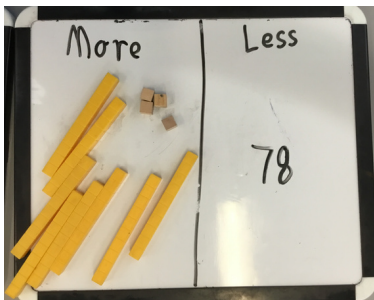
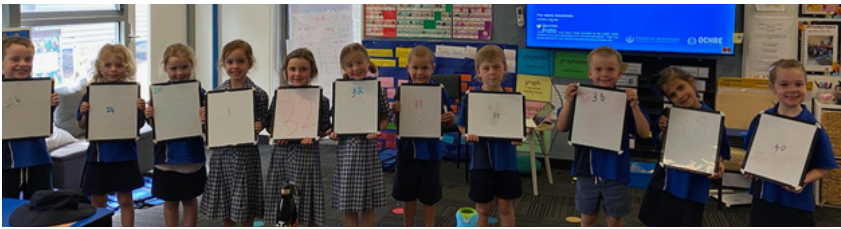


# Foundation!

## Literacy & Numeracy Update

Students have been exploring the 5 senses in content knowledge. Each week we have focused on a different sense, starting with sight and hearing. Over the next few weeks we will explore smell, taste and touch. Students have been writing statements to show how the senses help them experience the world around them. This has included walks outside, listening to a 'secret sound' and searching for different objects during an 'I Spy' game.

Students have been comparing the value of numbers in numeracy activities with numbers 0-100. They identify the 'tens' and 'ones' in each number before determining which number has a greater value.

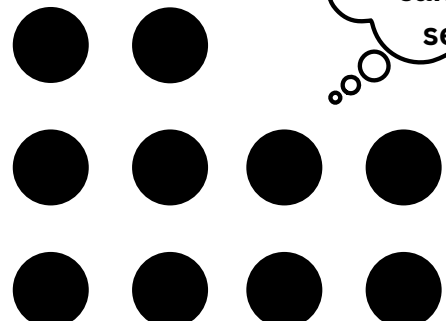
Foundation Excursion!
