Newton Trust Scholarships NOW OPEN

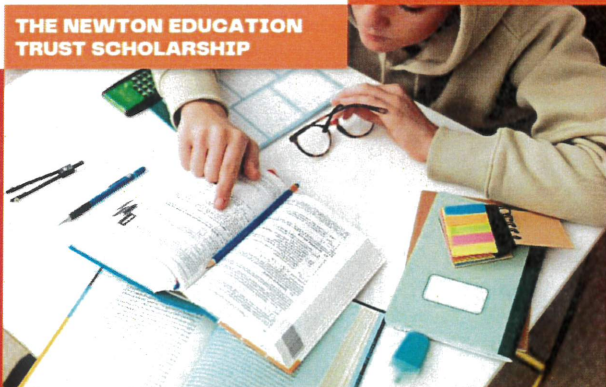

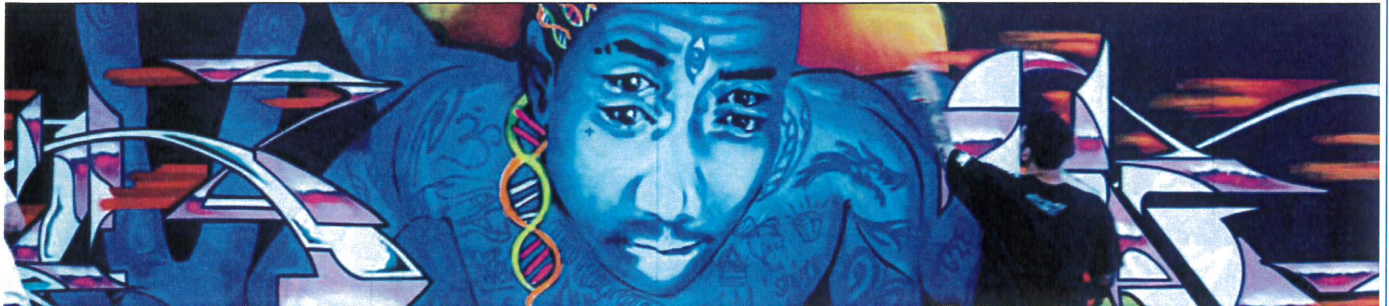
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STREET ART WORKSHOPS AT LATROBE YOUTH SPACE

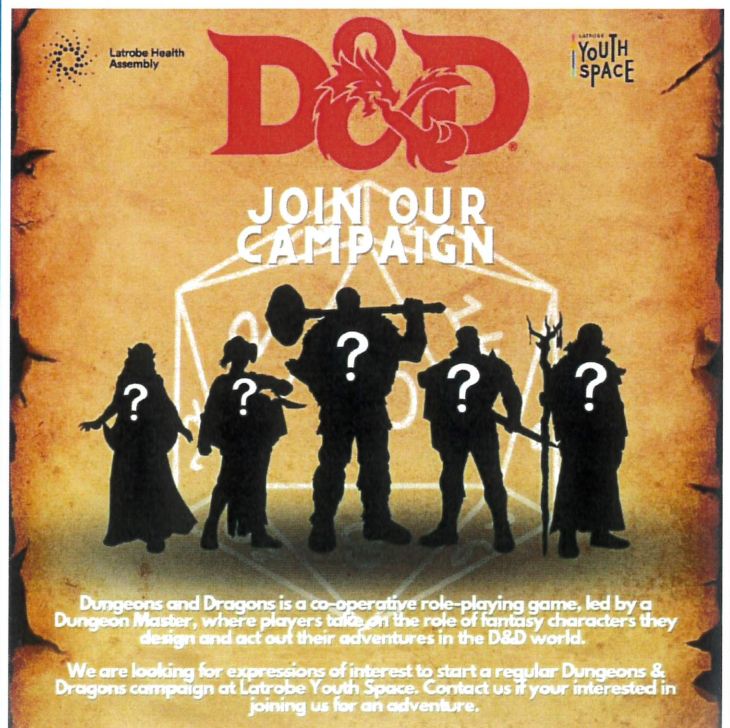


YoYo with a PoPo

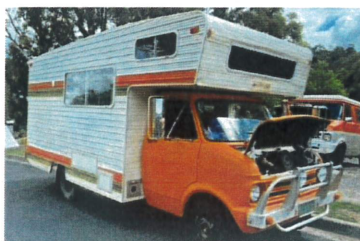

If you're aged between 14 and 20 years old and are going through a tough time or just want to get more out of life we may be able to help you.

Thousands of young people have experienced our weekend workshops and support groups over the last 30 years and say they are life-changing.

Youth Insearch program was written by young people for young people and is run by young people.

It's all about getting the help you need from other young people just like you - who've experienced the same thing and understand exactly what you are going through.

YoYo With a Po-Po - First Monday of the month, from 4pm - 5pm
Victoria Police will host a session at LYS to make biscuits and have a chat at the space

Art Workshop - Through these workshops, local artis; PollyannaR will work with young people to explore creative ways of expression, through various mediums, allow participants to find their way and communicate their thoughts, feelings and stories.

Kitchen Projects - Involves a variety of activities where you can socialise and learn some valuable kitchen and life skills, or just have some fun in the kitchen and grab a feed.

Van Reno Project - We are renovating an old van with the help of the Newborough Men's Shed to be crisis accommodation for youth. It will be a complete DIY and we will learn all the skills and knowledge we need along the way.

Garden Projects - We have a great garden developing at Youth Space, which is maintained by youth and volunteers. There's a wide range of activities to keep busy in the garden. Produce grown in the garden is used in the kitchen and donated to young people to take home.

DRUMBEAT - LYS will be hosting a series of come and try DRUMBEAT sessions, led by a trained facilitator. DRUMBEAT is fun and interactive social activity that incorporates the use of Djembe drums. It's a fun activity that helps you 'find your rhythm'.

Social Sports - You'll get the opportunity to participate in a range of outdoor and indoor sports and activities, with focus on fun and forming positive relationships, in a safe and inclusive environment.

Drop In - Drop in is a chance to use the space as you wish, after all it is your space. come in, hang out, use the wifi, charge your phone, play some games or do some art. We are always happy to have you here.
