Workshops

Bringing Up Great Kids

Suitable for parents of children from 2 to 12 years. Participants will learn about child development, strategies for effective communication, and mindfulness and self-care tools. Delivered over four weeks.

Calm and Confident Parenting Webinar Series

Join Meerilinga Parenting Service for a series of 30 minute webinars where we explore solutions to a wide variety of everyday parenting challenges. The webinars will be recorded and available on request, and the recording sent to those who register.

Circle of Security Parenting

Circle of Security Parenting is an 8 session program ideal for parents and carers of children 4 months to 6 years, and suitable for parents of children of all ages. The program is designed to enhance the bond and sense of security for both parents and their children. Learn more about:

- Understanding children and their emotional development
- Understanding parenting influences
- Helping children to feel safe in their world
- Identifying and enhancing parenting strengths

Family Fun Time

Songs, stories and games to help with tricky times and transitions. Enjoy a morning at the park with your 0-5 year old while learning about playful strategies to support family life to go smoothly.

Potty Time

A workshop for parents and carers of toddlers (aged 1-4). Ideal for those who have hit stumbling blocks with potty learning, this talk will give plenty of ideas for making the process light and enjoyable for everyone. Learn about when your child is ready for the potty, and the steps needed to build their confidence. We'll cover information from the Parenting by Connection approach to support connection and cooperation through the transition to using the toilet. There'll be time for Q&A and a chance to share successes and challenges.

Raising Children in a Digital World

Suitable for parents of children from 4 to 12 years. Participants will learn strategies to help them support their children in a digital world including how to best use technology to enhance their child's development, rather than detract from it.

Workshops

Ready for School

A two hour workshop presenting strategies for families to support the transition to school. Ideal for parents of children entering Kindy to Year 1.

1-2-3 Magic & Emotion Coaching

For parents/carers of children aged 3 - 10! Learn strategies to guide children's behaviour in a way that is positive and supports your child to develop skills for managing their big emotions, effectively communicate their needs, solve problems, and make positive choices. 4 week program. \$10 resource fee per family.

Starting Strong - Kindy

For parents/carers of children starting Kindy in 2024. Learn strategies to support your child to manage big feelings around change, separation, and the anxiety associated with starting school. Learn how you can equip your child with the skills to be assertive, confident, find and ask for help if needed, solve problems, make new friends, and more.

Starting Strong - High School

For parents/carers of pre-teens starting high school in 2024. This can be a challenging time for many students, as they experience anxiety around getting lost, multiple room and teacher changes across a day, older students, separation from friends, and increased homework. This session will equip you to support your pre-teen in managing these big changes and facing them with confidence. Learn strategies to support them to discover their strengths and to develop the skills they need for a strong and successful start to high school.

This group is for women who are from diverse cultural backgrounds and are seeking to develop new friendships and have fun learning about various topics such as parenting, budgeting, self-care, health and other topics.
