The College Charges are made up of three categories of payment:

Essential Educational Items are those items, activities or services that are essential to support student learning of the standard curriculum. These are items that the school considers essential for all students and which students take possession of. Parents may choose to provide the items themselves or buy the items from the school where practical and appropriate.

Optional Items are those items, activities or services that are offered in addition to or support instruction in the standard curriculum program. These items and activities are designed to broaden the school experience for your child and are provided on a user-pays basis so that if parents choose to access them for students, they are required to pay for them.

Voluntary Financial Contributions

You can make a general voluntary contribution that goes towards all of our school's important priorities for 2021 as well as providing additional activities and services for all students. Alternatively, you can make a voluntary contribution to specific priorities. The Building and Library fund contributions are tax-deductible. The College Health Centre is staffed by a qualified nurse/first aid attendant and is provided during school hours so that immediate attention to illness or injury is available to our students at all times. This service is provided by the EDSC School Council and is not funded by the Department of Education and Training and is not tax-deductible.

Your child will not be disadvantaged if you do not make a voluntary contribution. All records of voluntary contributions are kept confidential as well as your decision about whether to make a contribution or not.

We seek your cooperation in the payment of the College Charges by Monday 30 November 2020.

We are offering two payment options for 2021:

- **1.** Full payment can be made by CompassPay (*preferred*), Cash, EFTPOS or Credit Card on or before **Monday 30 November 2020.** *Please note, there is no additional fee to pay via CompassPay.*
- 2. Pay in two instalments with the first payment due on or before Monday 30 November 2020 and the following payment of the total balance on Tuesday 2 March 2021. Payments will be processed on or after these dates.

In 2021 we will continue with our whole school 1 to 1 Digital Learning Program for all students.

All students will be required to purchase a laptop. The purchase of these devices is crucial to the learning program as many students will need access eBooks and other e-platforms to support their learning. Details of the 1 to 1 Digital Learning Program and the booklists and resources required to be purchased for all Year 10-12 students will be available on Compass.
