



ManningJAM Youth Fest Logo Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

- Entry is to open to **primary and secondary school students enrolled in schools within the City of Manningham.**
- **One entry per student** is permitted.

2. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- All designs must be **original work** created by the student. • Entries must not include copyrighted material, logos, or images owned by others.
- Entries must be the student's own original work. **AI-generated or AI-assisted designs (including the use of image generators or AI design tools) are not permitted.**
- The design must include the words "**ManningJAM**" or "**ManningJAM Youth Fest**" only, and must not include the names or logos of any other organisations.
- Entries may be submitted as:
 - Digital files (JPEG or PNG), or
 - Hand-drawn artwork (submitted as a clear, high-quality scan or photograph, with artwork no larger than A4)
- The winning design may be **refined or redrawn in digital format** for use as the official logo, while preserving the original concept.

3. SUBMISSION DETAILS

- Each entry must include:
 - Student's full name
 - Age
 - Year level
 - School name
 - A short description of the design

4. JUDGING

- Entries will be judged by an independent panel appointed by the organisers.
- Judging criteria will include:
 - Creativity and originality
 - Visual impact and clarity
 - Relevance to the theme (music, youth, community)
 - Suitability for use as a logo
- A shortlist of 10 finalists will be selected, comprising **5 entries from primary school students and 5 entries from secondary school students.** The winning design will be selected from this shortlist.
- The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

5. PRIZE

- The winning entrant will:
 - Have their design selected as the **official ManningJAM Youth Fest logo**
 - Receive recognition across festival materials and at the event
 - Receive a prize of \$200 (donated by Echo3 Media)
- The organisers reserve the right to **not award a prize** if entries do not meet the required standard.

6. USE OF ENTRIES & INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- By entering the competition, participants agree that:
 - The winning design becomes the **property of the organisers** (ManningJAM Youth Fest, Whitehorse Rotaract, and Rotary Manningham City)
 - The organisers **may use, reproduce, adapt or modify** the design for promotional and branding purposes
 - The designer will be credited where practical
 - Shortlisted entries may also be displayed or used for promotional purposes, with appropriate credit

7. CONSENT & PRIVACY

- By submitting an entry, **parent or guardian consent is deemed to have been provided** for participation and for the use of the artwork as outlined in these Terms & Conditions.
- Participants consent to:
 - The use of the student's first name, school and year level in promotional materials
 - The display of submitted artwork online, in print, or at events
- Personal information will be used only for the purposes of administering the competition.

8. GENERAL

- The organisers reserve the right to **amend these Terms & Conditions** if required.
- The organisers are not responsible for lost, late, or misdirected entries.
- Participation in the competition constitutes acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.
