

# JUNIOR SCHOOL MUSIC 2026 INSTRUMENTAL TUITION YEAR 5



September 2025

Dear Parents,

I am writing to encourage your son to be part of the Music Instrumental Tuition programme in the Junior School. I would be very pleased if you could assist our planning in this regard by completing the attached form and returning it to the College Performing Arts Office no later than by **Friday 7 November 2025.** 

Music is a traditional strength of the College, and we encourage all students to take up a musical instrument and involve themselves in music making in the Junior School.

Involvement in music at the junior level is also more likely to lead to successful participation in the secondary school music groups such as the Senior Wind Orchestra, Swing Band, String Orchestra, Chorale.

In year 5, instrumental tuition can be selected in the following instruments: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Clarinet, Cornet, Trombone and Piano.

Further woodwind, brass, percussion, vocal and bagpipe instruments become available in year 6.

#### <u>Tuition Costs – Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass</u>

The string program is subsidised by the school. Lessons will either be shared (two per lesson) or individual 30 Minute lessons depending on the student's progress. The grouping of students into shared or individual lessons will be done by the school. <u>Please note that shared lessons are only available if two boys of similar standard wish to learn the same instrument.</u>

All shared 30-minute string lessons will cost \$780.00 for the year's tuition.

All individual 30-minute lessons will cost \$1,565.00 per year.

There will be no instrument hire fee.

#### <u>Tuition Costs - Flute, Clarinet, Cornet, Trombone and Piano</u>

Please note that a full woodwind, brass, and percussion program becomes available for the year 6 band program, as well as the bagpipes in the Pipes and Drums Band.

**Shared 30-minute** lessons in the junior school will cost \$780.00 for the year's tuition.

Please note that shared lessons are only available if two boys of similar standard wish to learn the same instrument. Where this in not the case a student will automatically be enrolled in an individual lesson.

An individual 30 Minute lesson will cost \$1,565.00 per year.

An individual 40 Minute lesson will cost \$2,090.00 per year.

Piano lessons are 40 Minute individual lessons at a cost of \$2,090.00 per year.

Instrument Hire Fees - Flute, Clarinet, Cornet, Trombone

For the music programme to operate successfully, students need to have access to instruments at a relatively low cost. To assist in this regard, an efficient **instrument hire** scheme is in place at the College. Parents may of course purchase their own instruments from music stores.

All listed instruments can be hired from the College at \$385.00 per year.

All students choosing Flute, Clarinet, Cornet, and Trombone will be asked to come in for an instrumental try out/interview prior to acceptance. Students may try more than one instrument before a decision is made.

Instrument tryouts will be held on **Monday 17 November 2025 between 9:00am and 11:00am** for students who have returned their enrolment form. For current Trinity students, a Music Tutor will collect them from their class. For new students to the College, Parents will be contacted to confirm their attendance.

I would hope to attract **all** students, who are currently not learning an instrument, into our instrumental programme. I therefore ask parents to carefully consider the likely benefits of learning an instrument.

All lessons commence in Week 2 of Term 1.

## **CONDITIONS OF TUITION**

Tuition should be undertaken for the entire academic year to guarantee the employment of hired teaching staff. Full annual tuition and hire fees are payable for withdrawals after Week 5 of Term 1. (Lesson 4)

Membership of a Trinity College Instrumental Ensemble becomes automatic when students reach the appropriate standard.

If a student is unable to attend a lesson, he must inform the instrumental teacher prior to the day of his lesson to allow another lesson to be arranged. Due to the nature of the school's computerised attendance records, lessons cannot be changed on the day. If insufficient notice is given, the lesson may not be rescheduled.

Accurate records of practice and lesson attendance will be kept in the student Practice Record Book which must be brought, duly signed by parents, to all instrumental lessons. Practice Record books are provided by the College and given to the students at their first lesson.

All instruments hired from the College become the student's responsibility. Students need to take all due care to maintain the instrument. Any negligent damage will be charged to the parents.
