Student Accommodation Options at UWA

Whether students are moving from metropolitan Perth, regional Western Australia, interstate or overseas, UWA offers a range of accommodation pathways designed to support their transition to university life.

Live at UWA On campus Residential Colleges

- Five residential colleges located on College Row adjacent to the UWA Crawley campus
- University Hall is owned and operated by UWA
- Primarily supports undergraduate students transitioning to university
- All-inclusive accommodation including meals, pastoral support, academic programs and student engagement activities
- Suitable for students seeking a structured and community-focused living environment

Live at UWA On campus Independent Living

- A new UWA-operated student accommodation development is currently under construction in Nedlands, Opening scheduled for February 2028
- Studio and 2 or 4 shared-apartment accommodation
- Applications are expected to open early 2027
- Crawley Village - UWA's postgraduate accommodation

Live with a family (Homestay)

- Suitable for under 18 domestic and international students and students who want hosted living arrangement
- UWA has two preferred providers - Australian Homestay Network and Talk About Homestay

You can apply to live at all five residential colleges on College Row



You can apply to live at a homestay

If you are an international student



You can apply to live at two of the residential colleges - University Hall & Trinity Residential College



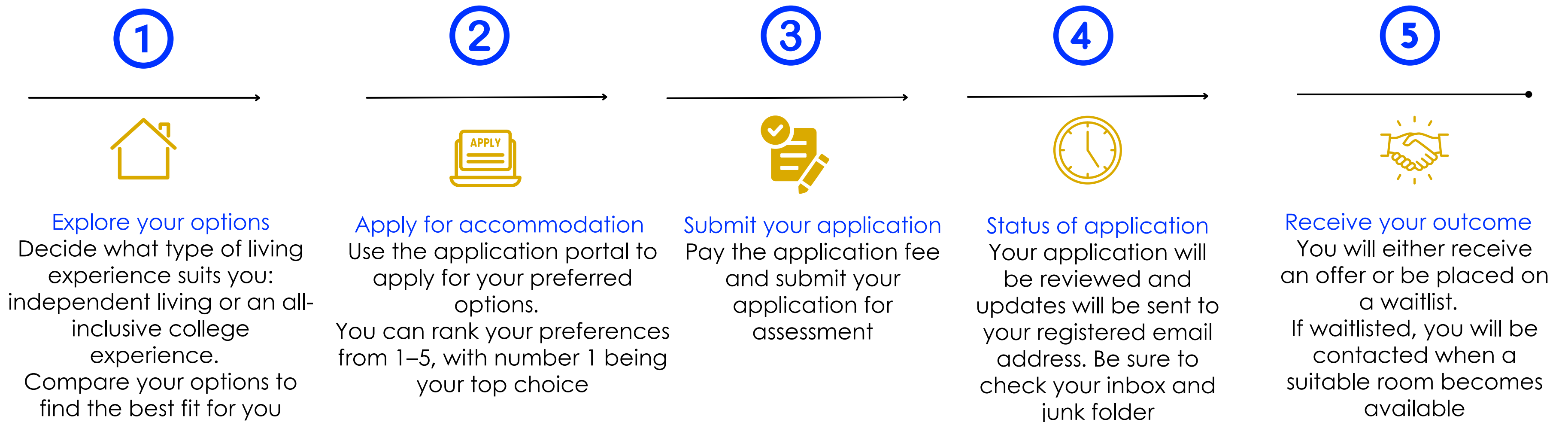
